
*Congratulation and a belated 'Happy Birthday' to long time member Joan Wilson who was 103 years young last week.*

Colour each of the crosses below, in the given colours, to show how great Jesus is.



**Red:** for the blood He gave, **Green:** for the grass He made, **Yellow:** for the sun so bright, **Orange:** for the dark of night, **Black:** for the sin we make,

**White:** for the grace HE gives

**Purple:** for the hour of sorrow, **Pink:** for our new tomorrow
