It's confession time and apologies to Rev Marc Prowe but my mind wandered slightly during last Sunday's sermon. What's a maths teacher to do when the Minister says he's not sure of the mathematical significance of a number? The number, of course, is 153. Straight away I recognised that it could be expressed as a multiple of Prime Numbers.

$$3 \times 3 \times 17 = 153$$

At that point I had to stop my mind from wandering further and tune back into the sermon. But I did come home and do a wee bit more tinkering with the number. I love a number conundrum. (Apologies to those who are now having horrendous thoughts about secondary school maths classes – I know it's not everyone's cup of tea!). Here are two more interesting facts:

$$(1 \times 1 \times 1) + (5 \times 5 \times 5) + (3 \times 3 \times 3) = 1 + 125 + 9 = 153.$$

$$\text{And if we add all the numbers from 1 to 17, } 1+2+3+4+\dots+17 = 153$$

Marc explained that 153 may have been the number used as it was thought that there was 153 different species of fish. In the Gospels there are 153 accounts of people being personally blessed by Jesus. Whatever the reason we know that it signifies abundance and is a reminder of the abundance of God's love for us.
