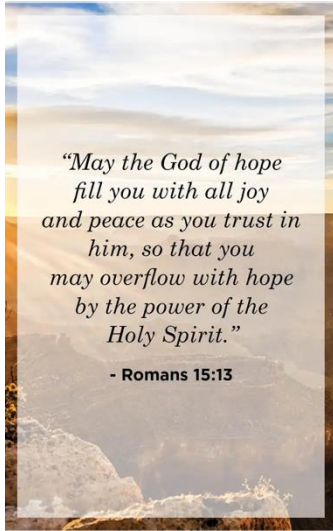




LOGIE & ST. JOHN'S (CROSS) PARISH CHURCH **WEEKLY NEWSLETTER: 18th April 2021**

VACANCY UPDATE: ELECTORAL REGISTER

As you know, Logie & St John's (Cross) is currently in vacancy. In order to progress the process to fill the vacancy we need to create our Electoral Register.

This Register is a list of everyone entitled to vote when the congregation is choosing a Nominating Committee or electing a minister. This includes people who are on our Congregational Roll and also others who are regular attenders, but who have not made a full commitment to membership of the Church of Scotland (known as adherents).

CHURCH MEMBERSHIP
