**SPACES FOR LISTENING - LIVING WITH CHANGE**

As part of our pastoral care strategy, we are using a 'Spaces for Listening' format, which encourages sharing and peer support. Earlier this year a small group gathered to listen to one another share stories around grief and loss. Over the autumn we will be facilitating a Space for Listening on the theme, '**Living with Change**'.

Change is something we all must navigate and work through- whether it is a change in personal circumstances, the ending of a relationship, retirement, loss of a job, a change in our own or someone else's health or dealing with a change in what we had planned for life.

Living with change can impact our physical, mental, emotional, and spiritual well-being. In the face of change we can feel isolated, anxious, and wonder where God is.
