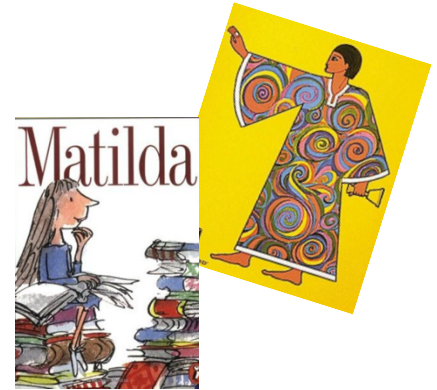

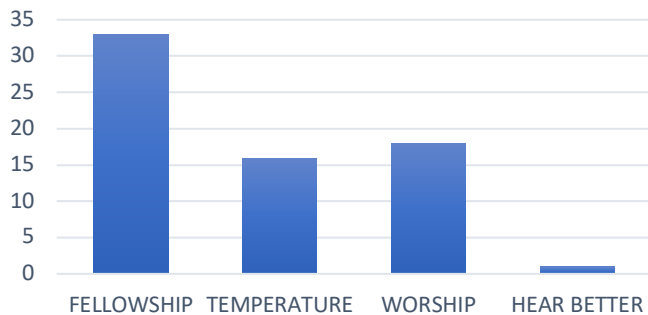
There are times when it's just good to talk to someone else about a concern and Grant is always willing to listen.

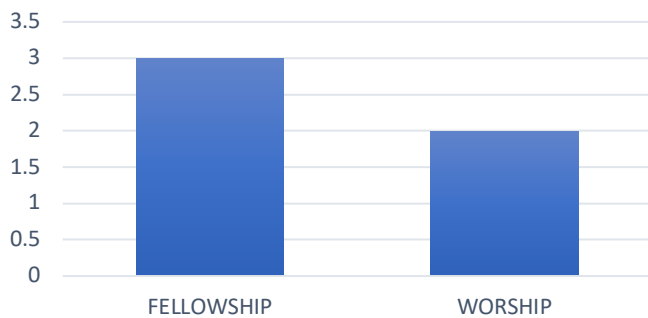
SERVICES

45 people present last Sunday responded to a series of questions to gauge thoughts around spending worship time in the Hall. These graphs show some of the results.

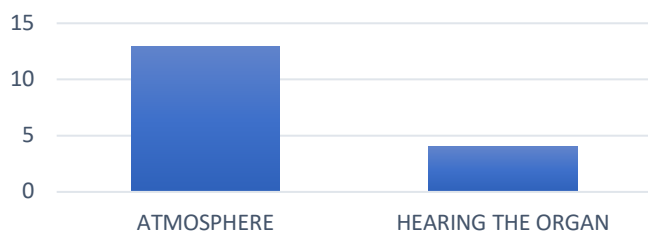
What have you enjoyed?



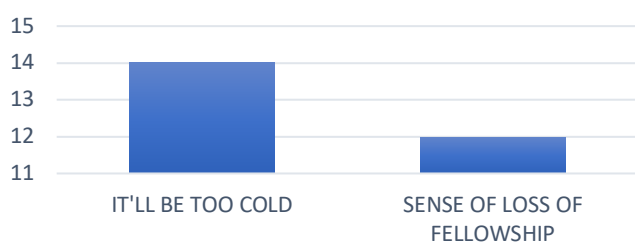
What have you not enjoyed?
