-Setting up an agreement with each new hall booker

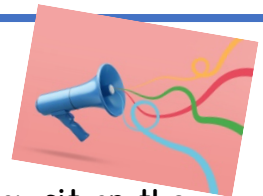
-Ongoing managing of each booking, including arranging payments with Treasurer, ensuring holidays are notified to us and recorded, ad hoc queries and occasional visits
