CHRISTMAS CAROL AFTERNOON: SUNDAY 3rd DEC@2.30pm

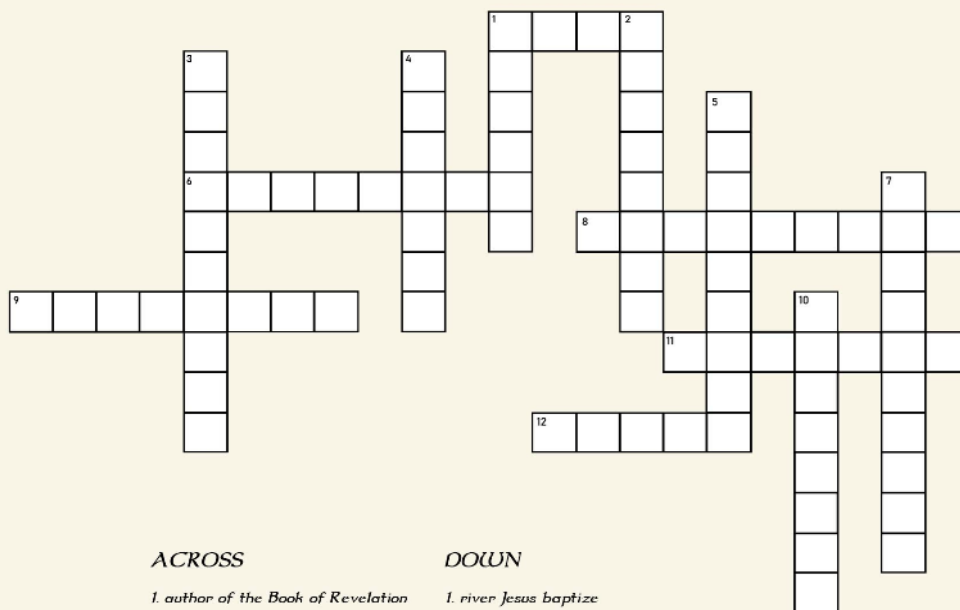
