

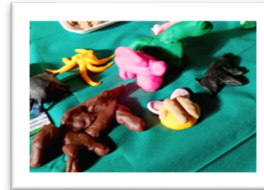

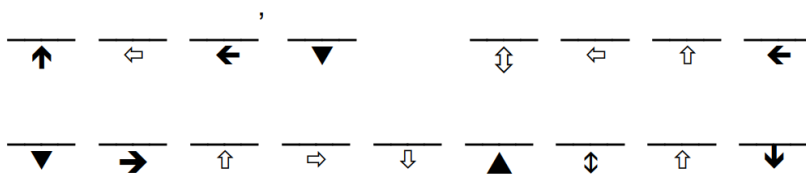
Some activities about the Bible
