**Lochee Parish Church at 2pm.**

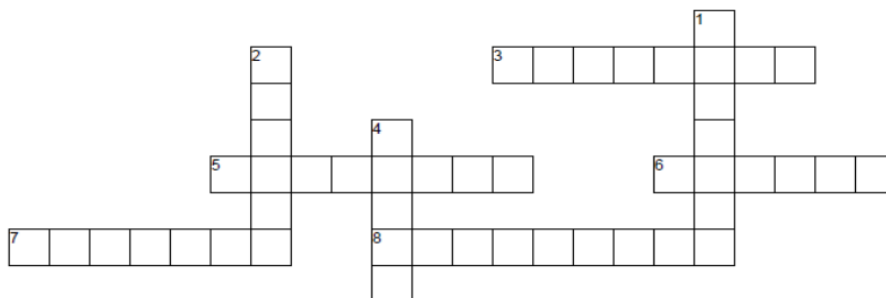
