# Worship Leaders

### Priests and Levites

In the Old Testament God chose **AARON** (brother of Moses) to be the **HIGH PRIEST**. Aaron's **SONS** and **GRANDSONS** would also be **PRIESTS**. The priests were the **LEADERS** for **WORSHIP**. The job of the priests was to present the people's animal **SACRIFICES** to God.

Aaron was a descendant of Levi (one of the sons of Jacob). All of the other **LEVITES** (descendants of Levi) besides Aaron and his family would be the **HELPERS** for the priests. They had two jobs – to take care of the **TABERNACLE** or **TEMPLE**, and to lead the **MUSIC**.

The tabernacle was a worship **TENT**, and the temple was a **BUILDING** for worship built later.
